

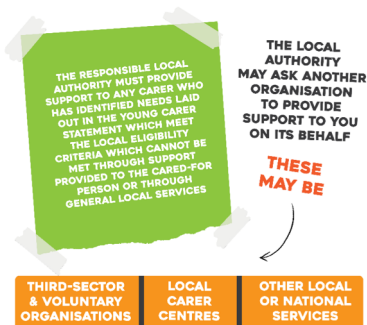
IT SHOULD INCLUDE

- ✓ WHAT PERSONAL OUTCOMES MATTER IN ORDER TO HAVE A LIFE ALONGSIDE CARING AND TO IMPROVE THEIR OWN HEALTH AND WELLBEING
- ✓ SUPPORT AVAILABLE TO YOUNG CARERS LOCALLY
- ✓ ANY SUPPORT WHICH THE RESPONSIBLE LOCAL AUTHORITY INTENDS TO PROVIDE
